### **Kirsten's administration updates**

- Piloting a new capstone project for the grade 7 graduates. GFSS graduates also does a capstone project in grade 12 for graduation.
- Science world presentation tomorrow- science of sport

- End of year funds from PAC discussion as teachers are asking if it will be given again.

### **Trustees report by Larissa Van Marck**

- Changes from The Ministry of Education is that they are requiring all high schools and eventually elementary schools to have an AED and Naloxone kits. It will not be funded by the ministry. September 8<sup>th</sup> 2027 all schools are mandated to have the AED and Naloxone kit.
- Ages 8-10 years old are having issues, the district is looking for collaboration with FISS to help with behaviours and issues.
- Family counselling – Boundary Integrated Services Model can be referred now through the school, referrals to Daren Pratt at FISS- with counselor Colleen Sheisler. Able to fund 8 sessions per family funding.
- New superintendent will be coming to shadow before the school year ends. Our current is finishing up the year 2025/2026 school year.
